### MONTHLY PRAYER MEETING

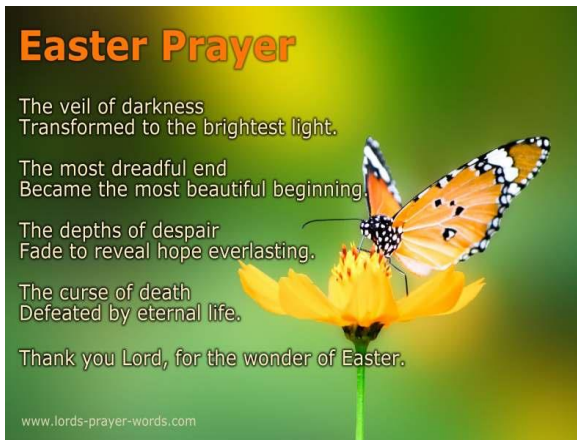
We meet in St George's Church on the last Wednesday of the month at 7pm to pray together for our church, community and world.
