There is no requirement to pray out loud at these meetings, but they offer a space of quiet reflection and collective prayer.

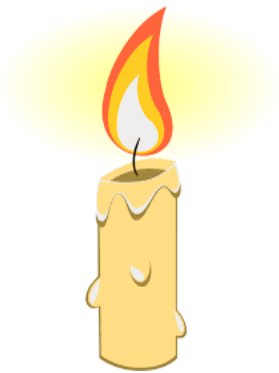
PRAYER THROUGH THIS TIME
